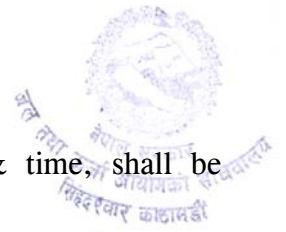

The evaluation of RFP documents of JV consulting firm(s) will be done in cumulative basis. The Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) procedure will be used for final selection of the consulting firm.
